

TO ARMS, TO ARMS...

This was the rallying cry of a colonist rebel named Israel Bissell as he rode from Boston to Philadelphia to start colonists rallying for the American Revolution just after the “shot heard around the world” that upgraded the colonists’ rebellion from fighting words to just plain fighting. And killing. The “shot heard around the world” was the first in the Battle of Lexington and Concord on April 19, 1775. British General Gage was on a mission to intimidate the colonists – and grant them amnesty – if they would simply continue to “bow down and lick the hands” of the British monarchy. Many colonists were willing to take them up on this; but thank God, the real One, not all were. General Gage, following the wishes of British monarchy under King George III, was ready to forgive those colonists who were all too willing to put their heads down and comply. This “amnesty” applied even to the rabble rousers who were starting the trouble save two, Samuel Adams and John Hancock. These are the words of Samuel Adams, colonist rebel, Father of the American Revolution, and devout man of God, the real One:

If ye love wealth better than liberty, the tranquility of servitude better than the animating contest of freedom, go home from us in peace. We ask not your counsels or your arms. Crouch down and lick the hands that feed you. May your chains set lightly upon you, and may posterity forget that ye were our countrymen.

What the great Samuel Adams, Father of the American Revolution and cousin to American great John Adams, was saying is simply this:

1. Join us and fight tyranny
2. Go home and hide; when it’s over maybe we’ll let you know
3. You’re the enemy

Of course General Gage’s other target, John Hancock gave England the figurative middle finger by making his signature the first and most visible on the greatest single political document of world history. It formalized the fight for real freedom while citing “the Supreme Judge of the world” and “Divine Provident”, i.e., God, the real One. In case you’re wondering this would be the Declaration of Independence.

Notice too Sam Adams mentions the word “chains”. Now these don’t necessarily have to be **physical** chains. Today many Americans including the overwhelming majority of the black population live under the “freedom” of the welfare state courtesy Ma and Pa Government. Black conservative Lincoln Institute calls this situation “the Liberal Plantation”. In other words, blacks (and now many others today, 2009, like many local governments, the elderly, GM and AIG) have merely traded in the physical chains of the evils of slavery to crouch down and lick the hands of others. These others would be “our” disgraceful Congress, “liberal” and so-called “Progressive” leaders and most of all the gang banker owners of the “Federal” “Reserve”.

Getting back, down in Virginia American patriot Patrick Henry had this to say at the situation of living under the “tranquility of servitude” of British rule in another famous speech that directly mirrors the Father of the American Revolution:

What is that Gentlemen wish? What would they have? Is life so dear, or peace so sweet, as to be purchased at the price of chains of slavery? Forbid it, Almighty God! I know not course what others may take, but as for me GIVE ME LIBERTY OR GIVE ME DEATH.

These guys were definitely NOT screwing around; neither should we.

But there’s more.

First of all how could those that would start a shooting war cite Jesus Christ, the Prince of Peace? Didn’t He say “those that live by the sword would die by the sword”? Yes. And would He want to have events come to things like the American Revolution? Absolutely not. But humans, who are given the free will to choose, sometimes leave Godly men and God Himself (after this see link Mystery, Babylon) no other alternative. The Old Testament is filled with great warriors like Moses and King David and battles where people were killed so it’s not all love and kisses when it comes to God, the real One. But for now let’s look at some passages from the New Testament that address this very situation. When Jesus was betrayed by the Satanically possessed Judas someone thought it best to fight *physically* as the Book of Matthew laments:

And Jesus said unto him, Friend, wherefore art thou come? Then came they, and laid hands on Jesus and took him. And, behold, one of them which were with Jesus stretched out his hand, and drew his sword, and struck a servant of the high priest’s and smote off his ear. Then said Jesus unto him, Put up again thy sword into his place: for all they that take the sword shall perish with the sword. Thinkest thou that I cannot pray to my Father, and he shall presently give me more than twelve legions of angels? But how then shall the scriptures be fulfilled, that thus it must be? (Verses 26:50-53)

This situation is reflected in the Book of John who identifies the servant as Simon Peter who would deny knowing Jesus hours later but would eventually become one of His greatest advocates:

Jesus answered, I have told you that I am he; if therefore ye seek me, let these go their way. That the saying might be fulfilled, which he spake, Of thou which thou gavest me have I lost none. Then Simon Peter having a sword, drew it and smote the high priest’s servant, and cut off his right ear. The servant’s name was Malchus. Then said Jesus unto Peter, Put up thy sword into the sheath: The cup which my Father hath given me, shall I not drink it? (John 18:7-11)

Now realize that a very fine line is being walked here (another good reason that the Word of God be followed in absolute just like the great Founding Fathers warned). Let’s look

at this situation very carefully because there's a lot happening here that is very relevant to this discussion. First, notice that one of Jesus' disciples, Simon Peter (the most prominent no less) was carrying a sword. Jesus apparently never told Simon to give it up. And even after Simon struck with his sword Jesus didn't say drop that thing but "Put up thy sword into the sheath".

Secondly, notice that Jesus said He could paste the whole scene with a simple call to "more than twelve legions of angels". (A legion was a Roman term for an organized military unit of approximately 6000 men). This includes all from the physical traitor Judas and the whole human crowd along with the fallen angel Satan, the very Prince of Darkness, who was allowed to "enter" into Judas just prior to these events. So Jesus, like His Father, God, real One, reserves the right to call in His own very real and very organized armies. And *these* armies of angels in the heavens, like the great rebels of the American Revolution, are definitely not screwing around. Hopefully you'll stick around and see in the Mystery, Babylon link on the home page as this time of a climactic battle for the "Cosmos" (Kosmos if for the UN-dead) may not be that far off.

Thirdly, notice Jesus is referring to prophecies being fulfilled. Jesus definitely knew Old Testament prophecy and discussed End Times (i.e. today) prophecy as well. He knew His job 2,000 years ago was to be the **perfect** human sacrifice to atone for ALL the sins of ALL mankind once and for all. The law of God demands perfect sacrifice. Why ultimately this is so is God's business; we need only to understand that in Jesus' dying words, "it is done". In Section 1 of the book, The Only Way, the literal fulfillment of over one hundred Old Testament prophecies in the form of Jesus Christ is one of the pillars that establish the truth of the Bible. In addition, hopefully it gets people used to the fact that if the Bible says it's going to happen, it's going to happen. Also, another reason for the truth of the Bible is that different writers discuss the same event from different perspectives all with minor details as we see in these two passages. As explained in Section 1 these factors help to establish the historical truth of the Bible to the highest standards of *all* history books, religious and secular.

Fourthly, lest we forget Jesus says "Put up again thy sword into his place: for all they that take the sword shall perish with the sword." Now is this a contradiction based on the aforementioned? Hardly. Let's see why.

Just after the Sermon on the Mount where Jesus put out all kinds of information on forgiveness, helping the poor and how to act properly in general He returned to the place where He spent a large part of His ministry, Capernaum. Soon after a Roman military commander approached Him looking for help with his dying servant. This exchange is recorded in the Book of Matthew:

And when Jesus entered into Capernaum, there came unto him a centurion, beseeching him, And saying, Lord my servant lieth at home sick of the palsy, grievously tormented And Jesus saith unto him, I will come and heal him. The centurion answered and said, Lord I am not worthy that thou shouldst come under my roof: but speak the word only and my servant shall be healed. For I am

a man under authority, having soldiers under me: and I say unto this man, Go and he goeth; and to another, Come and he cometh, and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth it. When Jesus heard it, he marvelled, and said to them that followed, Verily I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel. And I say unto you, That many shall come from the east and the west, and shall sit down with Abraham, and Isaac and Jacob, in the kingdom of heaven. But the children of the kingdom shall be cast into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth. And Jesus said unto the centurion, Go thy way; and as thou hast believed, so be done unto thee. And the servant was healed in the self same hour. (Verses 8:5-13)

As is normal with Biblical passages the inferences here are numerous but let's try to stay on message. Notice that this man is a soldier (i.e., his job is to kill people) and he has faith in Jesus. And did Jesus tell him to give up his position or his weapons of war? No. He simply said, "go thy way" and the servant was healed. It's peripheral here but just prior to this notice He gives a scathing review of the "children of the kingdom", namely His chosen people Israel. Throughout the Old Testament there are many occasions where Israel showed little appreciation for their God. Additionally, Jesus knew that many of these same people of Israel (i.e., the chosen ones) would turn on Him at the crucifixion. Getting back, the Bible is filled with a mixture of physical reality and symbolism that's meant for future generations. Is there a connection here not just to the immediate physical people in Capernaum but to some future people and place? This "conspiracy theorist" thinks so.

Capernaum, located in northern Israel around the Sea of Galilee, was the focal point, good and bad, of much of Jesus' ministry. First of all 5 of the 12 disciples came from there, fishermen Peter, Andrew, James, Simon and tax collector Matthew. Jesus also chose to set up shop in Peter's house for His stay there. During His stay He preached, healed many sick and performed exorcisms. Additionally, He had the aforementioned encounter with the Roman centurion.

However, Capernaum would soon fall out of favor with Jesus Christ, the real One. But first in Matthew 11 Jesus makes it clear that there definitely is a battle going on in heaven (that includes the Cosmos or Kosmos for the UN-dead):

And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, and the violent taketh it by force (Verse 12)

Now let's get back to Capernaum after it falls out of favor with Jesus Christ, the real One:

Then began he to upbraid the cities wherein most of his mighty works were done, because they repented not. Woe unto thee, Chorazin! Woe unto thee, Bethsaida! For if the mighty works, which were done in you, had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago in sackcloth and ashes. But I say unto you, It shall be more tolerant for Tyre and Sidon at the day of judgment, than for you. And thou, Capernaum, which art exalted unto heaven, shalt be brought

down to hell: for if the mighty works, which have been done in thee, had been done in Sodom, it would have remained unto this day. But I say unto you, That it shall be more tolerant for the land of Sodom in the day of judgment, than for thee. (Verses 20-24)

Tyre and Sidon were vibrant cities in Lebanon in Jesus' day that still stand to this day as Sayda and Sur, Lebanon, respectively. They were overtaken by foreign invaders in the BC era but remained as vibrant places of trade. Notice Capernaum is singled out as the equivalent of Sodom. As you may recall wicked Sodom was completely pased by God, the real One, after Abraham could not find 10 decent people in the entire city of thousands. Another place due a judgment similar to Sodom by God, the real One, at some point in the future is MYSTERY, BABYLON. As you'll see in the Mystery, Babylon USA link this Babylon is definitely NOT the place to be when the Book of Revelation unfolds in its entirety; it takes up at least two chapters in the Book of Revelation by itself. Notice the "USA" part. Also notice the above passage mentions "cities". It is this "conspiracy theorist's" supposition that the modern day Capernaum/Babylon is New York City if not the entire United States. In brief, "The Late Great USA" was started as a series of evangelical events that cited "the Supreme Judge of the World" and "Divine Provident". Everybody, even many so called atheists and "liberals", have to admit that this is (was?) the greatest country in the history of the world, the Very light of the world. Was it ever perfect even at its founding? As our less than stellar treatment of the Indians at times and the institution of slavery indicate, absolutely not. But ALL humans are imperfect and a God believing people over time eventually rectified much of this evil. Also, look at all the good and hope this country used to bring to this entire dark world. God did truly bless America and the world through it at one time.

So what happened?

The gang banker criminals at the "Federal" "Reserve" took it over from within, just like many, including the great Senator Joe McCarthy, warned. Yelling this warning from the rooftops was also paramount to the Founding Fathers and great Presidents like Andrew Jackson and Abraham Lincoln. And it could only happen if the people allowed it; and we have. In summary, just like Capernaum we have gone from God's favor to His impending judgment.

Recall the Roman commander from before. He seems to represent the great General and President George Washington. Washington was a great warrior and the very glue that held this post-Revolution fledgling country together. His "rock star" like status was absolutely necessary for the post war colonies to unite as the United States, the most Godly and greatest country in the history of the world. At the same time Washington, who could easily have crowned himself king, was a humble man of God who warned, just like the rest of the Founding Fathers, that we all must *ultimately* rely on a standard and a rule book above and beyond human hands. In a word, the Bible. We've fallen far, far away from our founding. In a nutshell, as meticulously documented in "The THEorY of LIVEvolution", this situation is at the core of the so-called "conspiracy". (As a side bar many "conspiracy theorists" imply that George Washington and many of the

Founders were merely part of the Freemason bid to overtake everything. As discussed in the “THEorY of LIVEvolution” this “conspiracy theorist” couldn’t disagree more. But that’s whole other discussion.)

So how do we fight this? How do we bring America back? We don’t. Face it, people that really understand how this country is supposed to work are cast off as “extremists” and “intolerant” and worse. The time for the *physical* fight to make things right is past; that was the American Revolution. Jesus told Simon to “put up” his *physical* sword when He and the 11 remaining Apostles were surrounded by a crowd of hundreds of those who turned on Him. Today we too are surrounded (see my Circle of Life on the bottom of the New Age page on this web site). Think about it. Who are we going to fight? The gang banker “Federal” “Reserve” who have robbed the country blind while we stared right at it as all the so-called “experts” debate its “merits” and “strategies”? Do this and what’s left of the country will end up in civil war leaving the “religion of peace” and its new Russian and Chinese allies to move right in. If we decide to fight the “religion of peace” that wants us Muslim or dead than we have to borrow even more from the gang bankers and we’ll fail financially (which is happening anyway). And don’t forget the illegal immigrant invasion of the “Late Great USA”.

People keep voting in these sell out leaders to Congress and the “President” from “both” parties that essentially have become subservient to our devil worshipping Illuminati/Freemason criminal masters (if you think this is “crazy” stick around for the related links page on the Mystery, Babylon link). But we choose to “crouch down and lick the hands that feed us” with the current fake, illegal Federal Government and their fake, illegal gang banker “Federal Reserve Notes” just like the great Samuel Adams warned against from a by-gone era. There’s no way a banksta criminal like David Rockefeller and friends like Henry Kissinger, Maurice Strong, George Soros and Ted Turner can peacefully take over an entire nation unless many in the “imbecile majority” let it happen. This whole concept brings to mind the situation of the wheats and the tares discussed in the Gospel. The concept is that near the end the enemies (tares or weeds) would become inseparable from the “good guys” (the wheat). (And we haven’t even discussed cyber terror, electromagnetic pulse (EMP) bombs, the whole global warming scam being treated as “security issue”, the disgraceful UN-dead controlling our laws and government, etc. etc. AND we haven’t touched on natural disasters, nasty things like the bird flu, multi-drug resistant bacteria, potentially disastrous solar storms, etc. etc.)

We, just like the Founding Fathers, need to “have mutual reliance on Divine Providence” to bring this country back i.e., the very Creator and Controller of EVERYTHING. I’ll give you a hint, it ain’t gonna happen. Case in point is presidential candidate Alan Keyes. He understands this principle perfectly but he cannot even get into the so-called presidential debates and when he does he is mocked, scorned and belittled. He is just the messenger and his warnings, just like those of all serious Christians these days, are going unheeded. Therefore, in this spiritual “Battle of the Alamo” our arms becomes simply

the Word of God. In the Book of Revelation God discusses the “Sword of my mouth” and He is coming back as a great warrior with His “legions of angels”. Later on we’ll look into this “spiritual war” that doesn’t necessarily conform to our physical understanding of war and even “time” (see related links on the Mystery, Babylon USA page). For now suffice it to say that this “war” for “the Cosmos or Kosmos” cannot be fought with physical weapons any longer, “THEY”, with help from our devil worshipping Illuminati/Freemason gang banker owners and lackeys out here in the “imbecile majority”, have us surrounded. And as we’ll see the “enemy” being led by a certain “Angel of Light” is gruesome beyond compare.

In summary, it is this "conspiracy theorist's" supposition that *it will* be more tolerable for Sodom in the Day of Judgment than for this place, “The Late Great USA” and the only thing left to do is arm ourselves with the Word of God, the real One.
